## **CFWV College Fair Tip Sheet**

## Before the Fair

- Think about what you are looking for in a college.
  - o Do you want to attend an extra-large, large, medium, or small size school?
  - o What majors are you interested in?
  - o Do you want to go to an urban, suburban, or rural school?
  - o Do you want to attend a 2-year, 4-year, religiously affiliated, or career tech ed school?
  - Do you want to participate in athletics, clubs, fraternities or sororities, or special programs such as study aboard?
  - Other items to consider and ask about: student housing options, availability of transportation, the average class size, specific questions about programs and majors and specific institutional financial aid that may be available.
- Make a list of questions to ask the college representatives ahead of time. Try to think of questions that are insightful and not easily answered from the college website or cfwv.com.
- Save yourself time now and register online to create a personal barcode that college representatives can scan! This will keep you from filling out info cards repeatedly at each table you visit. Register here: <a href="https://app.strivescan.com/visit">https://app.strivescan.com/visit</a>

## At the Fair

- Be sure to visit the CFWV table to grab a bag for all the college materials that you collect.
- While at the CFWV table, opt into the Txt-4-Success program by texting "CFWV" to 304-921-CFWV (2398) to begin receiving special text messaging services like college tips, important reminders, and real time help from a college access advisor.
- Visit schools that match or are a close match to your preferences.
- Ask the same questions to each college representative you visit. It will help you compare them.
- Make sure each college representative that you visit scans your barcode so that you can receive additional information from that postsecondary institution or military branch.
- Take notes about the information you have gathered.
- Get out of your comfort zone. Don't just walk to the well-known schools.
- Apply to schools that are of interest to you as many of them will provide fee waivers during the college fair.
- Be sure to head back to the CFWV table to find out information about the Promise Scholarship,
  WV Higher Ed Grant, WV Invests Grant, and all financial aid information!

## After the Fair

- Review the information (brochures, handouts, pamphlets) you gathered to help you narrow down your college choices.
- If you applied to a college during the College Fair, be sure to follow up with any additional information and paperwork that is required.
